

GRADUATING STUDENT SURVEY (GSS) RESULTS REPORT 2016 & 2017

Executive Summary

The Graduating Student Survey (GSS) was administered April 24th - May 12th 2017 to 266 Halifax Community College graduating students in curriculum programs seeking certificate, diploma, and/or associate degree credentials, excluding high school equivalency students and inmates. One-hundred fifty-nine out of 266 students completed the survey yielding a *response rate of 59.8%*. This rate represents a *three percentage-point increase* in comparison to the *spring 2016 response rate of 56.3%* (180 of 320).

Spring 2017 graduating respondents reported an *overall level of satisfaction* with their *HCC experience at 95%* compared to *98.3% of 2016 respondents*. In addition to this high level of overall satisfaction, *94.3% of 2017 respondents* (151) stated that the *educational environment* at HCC *provided* them with *life skills* (2016 respondents (171) reported a 93.3% satisfaction level). *All 2017 respondents* (100%) were satisfied with their ability to communicate effectively in writing (98.9% in 2016). Upon graduating, 2016 and 2017 graduates reported high levels of satisfaction with their ability to demonstrate:

- effective oral communication (2017 99.4%; 2016 98.9%),
- fundamental math skills (2017 97.4%; 2016 98.3%),
- non-technical skills applicable in the workplace (2017 98.7%; 2016 100%),
- competency in the basic use of computers (2017 98.7%; 2016 98.9%),
- specialized skills related to program of study (2017 99.4%; 2016 98.9%).

The satisfaction rating by HCC graduating classes for *the College overall* is 96.8% (2017) and 98.3% (2016). Other areas with the *highest levels of satisfaction* (97 - 100% very satisfied/satisfied) include the following:

Purpose for Attending HCC and Employment

Of the 159 respondents (2017) 96.2% attended HCC for the purpose of earning an associate degree, diploma and/or certificate (97.2% in 2016 – 180 respondents). In addition to seeking a credential, 45.3% (2017) and 50% (2016) were preparing for a new job; 28.9% (2017) and 31.1% (2016) of graduates stated that they planned to transfer to a four-year institution.

At the time the survey was administered, **56.1% (2017)** and 53.3% (2016) of respondents were **employed**. Job conflict, new employment, financial hardship and medical issues were the most commonly cited reasons respondents did not fully accomplish their goal(s) for attending. However, **70.8% (2017)** and 50% (2016) cited "other" for not accomplishing their goal(s). In **2017** an additional cited reason emerged as **25% of respondents cited dissatisfaction with the quality of instruction** as a reason for "not or partially accomplishing their goal(s)" compared to 9.1% in 2016.
