## What is the RN2BSN Program?

With this program, you can complete your Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree through North Carolina Central University in two years or less at Halifax Community College. The program is designed to meet the needs of registered nurses with either an associate degree or a diploma in nursing who wish to pursue a baccalaureate degree in nursing.

To be considered for admission to this degree completion program, you must hold a current unencumbered license as a registered nurse in the state in which you will do clinical coursework. Admission requirements for the RN2BSN program at HCC are the same as for the on-campus program.

The degree completion program requires you to take a 3-student-credit-hour bridge course and 30 semester credit hours of upper-division nursing courses, in addition to general education and completion requirements of NCCU. Because each student's academic record is unique, you will consult with an academic advisor to determine your specific requirements.

This program is accredited by the National League for Nursing and is approved by the North Carolina Board of Nursing.
