

Articulation Agreement

Between

North Carolina Wesleyan College

and

Halifax Community College

North Carolina Wesleyan College, Incorporated and Halifax Community College hereby enter into the following agreement governing the matriculation at North Carolina Wesleyan College of graduates from Halifax Community College.

This contract shall begin on May 1, 2005 and shall continue until May 1, 2012. At that time both institutions will undertake renegotiation of the agreement. In the event that either institution finds it necessary to cancel the Articulation Agreement, notification must be made in writing at least one year preceding the date of termination.

The objectives of this agreement are:

1. To promote the easy transition of qualified transfer students from Halifax Community College to bachelor degree programs at North Carolina Wesleyan College.
2. To provide specific information for transfer students intending to pursue bachelor's degrees.
3. To provide an alternate route to quality education for students who have not been able to follow a one-college program.

The parties to this agreement, North Carolina Wesleyan College and Halifax Community College, hereby agree to the following terms and conditions set forth herein.

North Carolina Wesleyan College agrees to grant any student who is the recipient of an associate degree from Halifax Community College, in the areas listed below, sixty-four hours towards the baccalaureate degree and junior standing.

The parties further agree that the holder of an associate degree from Halifax Community College who elects to continue his or her studies toward a baccalaureate degree at North Carolina Wesleyan College will be required to satisfy all program and degree requirements, as described in the North Carolina Wesleyan College catalog, effective at the time of his or her initial enrollment at Wesleyan. The student will be advised of those requirements at or before the time of matriculation. Since remaining degree requirements will be determined by specific courses transferred and remaining general education, major, and elective requirements at Wesleyan, students may be required to complete more than the minimum semester hours required for graduation.


Associate degrees included in the articulation agreement are listed below. Each college may not offer all programs included in agreement.

Course work in associate degrees not listed above is not included in the articulation agreement but will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis.

North Carolina Wesleyan College will designate a member of the admissions staff to maintain liaison with Halifax Community College to facilitate the transfer of students who have completed their degree program at Halifax Community College. Halifax Community College will do the same. North Carolina Wesleyan College requests that Halifax Community College forward to North Carolina Wesleyan College a list or computer file of the names and home addresses of any student anticipating the completion of an associate degree in the areas listed above.


